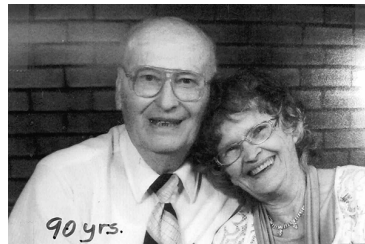


A Forgotten Story Remembered
